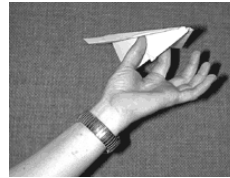










Nakamura Lock - Paper Airplane



Instructions

	<p>1. Fold a sheet of paper in half lengthwise.</p> <p>Unfold so that the crease is 'valley' side up.</p>
	<p>2. Fold the top corners down to the center fold.</p>
	<p>3. Fold the tip down.</p>
	<p>4. Fold about one inch of the tip up; unfold.</p>
	<p>5. Fold the top corners down to the center fold so that the corners meet above the fold in the tip.</p> <p>(Note that the the nose of the plane should be blunt.)</p>
	<p>6. Fold the tip up.</p> <p>This is the Nakamura lock.</p>
	<p>7. Fold the entire plane in half so that the tip is on the outside.</p>
	<p>8. Fold the wings down.</p> <p>Trim and fly!</p>
